



Expenses covered for the 2026 National Summit

May 4-6, 2026

Air or Ground Transportation to the Summit for 2 people from your organization:

- 1 in leadership and 1 in front-line
- Economical fare for air or ground transportation
- We will arrange the booking. Should your organization decide to book transportation, please let Amanda Kilabuk know
- Estimated travel days are May 3 and May 7th/8th

Accommodation

- 3 nights at the Delta Hotel City Centre: May 3, May 4, May 5
- Room and taxes are covered
- A valid credit card will be required for incidentals at check-in

Meals

- Breakfast will be provided on May 4, May 5 and May 6
- Lunch will be provided on May 4, May 5 and May 6
- Supper will be provided on May 5

What your organization will be responsible for:

- Transportation to and from the airport
- Transportation to and from hotel
- All meals on travel days, including supper on May 4 and May 6
- Incidentals

We don't reimburse per diems, taxis, or individual travel claims because with over 100 delegates, managing per diem payments and reimbursements would create a significant administrative burden and delay support reaching participants. Instead, we designed the Summit travel support model one as equitable and streamlined as possible by directly covering the major costs upfront, including: air transportation for 2 delegates per organization, hotel accommodation, and meals during the Summit. Our goal was to ensure the biggest barriers - flights, hotel and core meals - are covered directly so participants can attend without having to pay large upfront costs or wait for reimbursements.
